Procedures for reporting lost, stolen, damaged or destroyed pagers and portable radios

- 1. Report incident to the Communications Committee immediately upon discovery. Call the ADO at fire dispatch and have them pager Car 49 for pager & radio related issues. Or Contact Car 53 VP of OPS. If a radio is missing you most give the ADO the exact radio designation, such as Engine 542 P2, as the radio must be shut off immediately.
- 2. Complete a police report if the equipment is lost or stolen.
- 3. Complete a detailed written account of what occurred to cause damage or loss to the equipment. The report should be completed using the BCVFA Electronics Incident Report and the completed report is to be emailed to the BCVFA-ADMIN@baltimorecountymd.gov and the VP of OPS
- 4. A copy of the police report (if completed) must be forwarded to the EMAILS above as well.
- 5. The fire company is responsible for making payment to Baltimore County for the equipment that is lost, stolen destroyed or damaged beyond repair. The company will receive a written statement as to the amount owed and will be expected to remit payment in a timely manner. <u>All checks for payment should be sent to the attention of the BCVFA office.</u> <u>All checks should be made out to Baltimore County, Maryland</u>.
