SUBJECT: DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

DIVISION: FIRE-RESCUE ACADEMY

Objective: To outline the intended duties and responsibilities of the Fire-Rescue Academy.

Section 1: It is the duty and responsibility of the Fire-Rescue Academy to maintain an up-to-date and effective training program to meet the needs of the career and volunteer firefighter.

A. The Fire-Rescue Academy shall:

- 1. Prepare and maintain an up-to-date recruit program in accordance with S.O.P. 700-4 (Recruit Training Manual).
- 2. Instruct recruits according to the training program as outlined by S.O.P. 700-4 (Recruit Training Manual).
- 3. Research and develop new concept in Fire Service Training.
- 4. Test and evaluate new tools and equipment to be purchased by the Fire Department.
- 5. Develop and maintain training programs.
- 6. Maintain an up-to-date training record on all Fire Department personnel.
- 7. Schedule and conduct training requested by Baltimore County Career/Volunteer Fire Companies.
- 8.. Coordinate the Baltimore County Volunteer Training requests for Maryland Fire and Rescue Institute Programs.
- 9. Maintain an master file on all training reports submitted by the Baltimore County Volunteer Fire Companies.
- 10. Certify all emergency vehicle drivers within the Baltimore County Fire Department in accordance with the procedures for Driver Certification.
- 11. Conduct training programs to familiarize personnel in the latest procedures, equipment and techniques being adopted by the department.
- 12. Assist in conducting the Physical Ability Tests given to Fire Department applicants as scheduled by the Applicant Investigation Division.
- 13. Conduct annual certification tests on all career engines and ladder trucks.
- 14. Inspect all training vehicles for both career and volunteer training purposes.
