SUBJECT: Training Aids

DIVISION: Emergency Operations

Objective: An update of training aids available to Fire Department Personnel.

Section #1: The Fire-Rescue Academy has the necessary equipment available on a loan basis, to allow station personnel to utilize the listed visual aids stored at the Fire-Rescue Academy.

- A. The following is an operating procedure which has been implemented to help insure that needed materials are received on time.
 - 1. When personnel wish to use A/V materials, they shall contact the A/V Services to reserve needed materials.
 - 2. The person(s) needing the materials then shall contact the Driver/Messenger to arrange delivery and pick-up of materials.

Note: Tapes that are requested shall be sent out to stations and returned by inter-office mail directly to A/V.

Section 2: List of Equipment and Visual Aids available for use.

A. Equipment.

- 1. Film projector 16MM.
- 2. Slide projector.
- 3. Overhead projector.
- 4. Sound on slide projector.
- 5. Movie screens.
- 6. Video cassette player.
- 7. Opaque projector.
- 8. Tape recorder and player.
